History:

Awards:

These grants will facilitate a project designed to promote the active involvement or education of the parents of a classroom of gifted youngsters. These grants will be awarded for a project that other funds do not or cannot finance. The objective of the grant is to provide funding for a project that would otherwise not be possible as the teacher works to include parents to help secure the success of the GATE students.

Eligibility:

Educators who apply for the grant must be GATE certified.

Amount of Grant: \$250
